**PRAYER LETTER FOR FEBRUARY 2020**

March 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2020

Dear Friends,

This past month of February was an exciting month here in our ministries! We had the blessing of having Brother Lacey Wheeler, his wife and Missionary Chris King with us. They were here to help us organize a Bible distribution ministry. Brother Wheeler is serving the LORD in Mexico, but also has a distribution center in Tennessee from where he sends out thousands of Bible and Gospel tracts **free of charge** for missionaries and pastors in Latin America. Beginning this year, we will begin to receive thousands of Bibles and tracts that will be distributed for free to national churches and ministries. Our goal is to flood Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador with the precious Word of God! This means we will have to organize a separate nonprofit association made up of many of our members and like-minded brethren from other churches. **For that, we need to raise about \$2,000 which is what the lawyer needs to get it done.** According to him, it will take 6 months. Once approved, we can begin to import all the material which we know will be a major blessing to all. We anticipate that our first shipment will arrive in November. Would you prayerfully consider helping us with this one time gift?

We mentioned last month that we were trying to start our very own chapter of Reformer's Unanimous—a ministry of restoration for alcoholics and drug addicts. We decided to postpone this until we are able to import the printed material that is used for the men and women, and as soon as we can raise funds to fly the brethren in charge of this ministry. They would need their airline tickets paid for, as well as housing and meals. In the mean time, our medical clinic is actually already doing its best to evangelize, and treat many alcoholics who come to us seeking for help. I praise the LORD for leading two of them to Christ recently!


Pray as we continue training many of our people in our Bible Institute. We currently have 2 classes: Evangelism, and the Doctrine of the Scriptures. We meet every Saturday and Sunday.

Pray for our deaf ministry. We are asking God to send us someone who is trained in deaf work in order to assist us in reaching the deaf in our area.

Finally, we praise the LORD that our youth ministry has been actively conducting evangelistic teen rallies in neighboring communities. Thus far there have been hundreds of professions of faith! We are looking forward to having many of them come forward for believer's baptism as soon as the weather warms up!
