April 4th, 2020

In April we continued broadcasting our services on the Internet both to the hearing as well as to the deaf. As a result, we decided to make “*La Hora Bautista*” (The Baptist Hour) a permanent ministry, so even when the restrictions to meet in church are lifted we will continue broadcasting our services. His home going took us all by surprise, as he was doing so well, so we thought. Due to government restrictions, we could not attend his funeral; however, I was able to pray with the family at their home and share comforting Scripture before they buried him. He will definitely be missed by us all.

Now on to happier news--we rejoice that we were able to have a wedding recently! One of our young ladies, Joselyn Santos was married to one of our finest young men, Jonathan Sanchez. It was an unusual wedding consisting of just 10 people in the auditorium, all with masks (minus the couple!). Pray that this new couple will be greatly used of the Lord. Jonathan and Joselyn will be helping on Sundays in another work pastored by another fellow missionary.

We praise the Lord for allowing us to meet the physical needs of some of our impoverished members with dried rice, beans and vegetables. Many are unable to buy food for their loved ones, and God provided a way that we could help at this time.

Lastly, pray for baptisms—we have a few new converts lined up just as soon as we are able!
