Finally, in August we will be focused in reaching our young people. Seems we have lost contact with them, which apparently is easy to do in these times. Pray we can create an entire workbook full of activities and Bible studies, complete with tests. Upon completion, they will be graded. If they pass with an “A” they will receive a care package which will help in their household economy. It’s a way to incentivize them and provide food and medicine in such a needy time as this.
